

The Maryville Academy Children's Health Care Center contacted the Crisis Nursery regarding a family who has a daughter that has been admitted into their program for three months. The parents need to receive medical training for their daughter so that she can be discharged into their care. The training requires an overnight stay at the Center for Children however their two young children are not permitted to stay with them. The family shared that they have limited support and do not have a child care plan. FAW Erika met with the father, explained the program, completed paperwork, gave him a tour of the Crisis Nursery and made a plan for them to come on the day of their medical training. The Crisis Nursery is located in the same building as the Children's Health Care Center and the parents felt at ease dropping off their 5 year old daughter and 16 month old son while they stayed on the other side of the building. The Maryville Academy Center for Children was able to support this family and meet the needs of their children.
